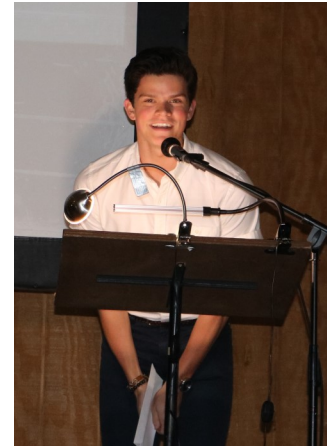
John B. Kolcum Scholarship Fund

The John B. Kolcum Scholarship is awarded annually to a qualified graduating high school student who shows interest, skill and talent in acting and/or technical and design aspects of theatre and wish to further develop these skills by majoring in Theatre Arts.

Application Instructions:

Candidates for the John B. Kolcum Scholarship must:

1. Submit an application packet, which must contain all of the following:
 - This completed application form
 - One letter of recommendation from someone familiar with your abilities in theatre or performance, it is recommended to be from a current academic teacher.
 - A resume listing your theatrical activities and accomplishments (both onstage and backstage) in high school and community theatre.
2. The applicant must audition/give presentation

Audition/Presentation Instructions:

From the applications received, Neuse Little Theatre's John B. Kolcum Scholarship Committee will invite a limited number of finalists to audition and interview.

Guidelines for Audition (if planning on a performance based major in Theatre Arts)

For students with primary experience in performance, the audition will consist of a presentation of two contrasting monologues (one dramatic, one humorous) selected, memorized and prepared for performance by the student. (Performing pieces that are read rather than memorized, or simply submitting videotapes of scenes produced for high school plays is discouraged.)

Live or videotaped auditions must include the following:

1. A memorized speech from pre-twentieth century dramatic literature, such as a monologue taken from one of William Shakespeare's plays, no longer than four minutes in length
or
A memorized contemporary piece of the student's choosing at least two minutes and no longer than five minutes (this piece may be an individual monologue or may be a dialogue performed with a partner)
2. Perform 16 bars of song with movement/dance (if theatre major involves musical theatre)

Guidelines for Presentation (if planning on a major in Technical Theatre Arts)

If the student's primary experience is in design/technical theatre, the auditions will consist of a four- or five-minute portfolio presentation in which the student will formally display and discuss his or her past work.



Criteria for Selection:

The John B. Kolcum Scholarship will be awarded based on the student's abilities as a performer, theatre technician or designer, as well as continued commitment to Theatre Arts.

The Scholarship recipient should:

1. Have and maintain a grade point average of 2.5 per term, 2.5 overall, and 3.0 in Drama courses.
2. Be planning to declare Theatre Arts as major.
3. Make a contribution (either on or back stage) to each production in the term (when allowed).
4. Be enrolled in at least one drama course (or prerequisite) per term.
5. Be a full-time (12 hour load minimum) student.

- * An audition/portfolio review is required to receive a Theatre scholarship (or renewal)

All applicants must attach the following:

1. a Neuse Little Theatre "John B. Kolcum Scholarship Application Form"
2. a 1-2 page current resume containing a listing of theatre-related experience and training and previous awards and honors received. This should include all work in theatre and may also include work in speech, music or dance.
3. Submit a current sealed letter of recommendation from person, with expertise in theatre, speech, music or dance, qualified to assess your educational and artistic potential as a theatre professional, and has enough experience with you they can comment on your work. To ensure confidentiality, ask your referees to sign across the envelope seal.
4. **Optional but of potential benefit to your application.** You may send us photos or videos of your work. If you enclose a self-addressed and stamped envelope, we will try to return them, but we cannot take responsibility for any losses that may occur.
